
# Espirais


Alongside drummer **Paulinho Vicente** and bassist **Felipe Brisola**, the pianist reinforces the importance of collective improvisation in his eighth album.

#### Release

Immerse yourself in the essence of Brazil with the captivating sounds of the new album from the **Salomão Soares Trio.** "**Espirais**" ("**Spirals**") is a music experience that explores the rich Brazilianness of the composer, the freedom of improvisation, and the perfect interplay between the musicians. In this work, pianist Salomão Soares is joined by two great names in music: Paulinho Vicente, with his modern and jazz-infused drumming, and Felipe Brisola, with his creative and solid double bass. "Espirais" is now available on all digital platforms.

The compositions, all by Salomão Soares, are original, some paying tribute to artists or places that inspire the pianist's work. *Luzes do Carmo* is dedicated to Egberto Gismonti, one of his greatest influences. *Dalí* honors the Spanish artist Salvador Dalí, whose surrealist paintings captivate the musician. *Espirais*, which gives the album its name, is inspired by the painting The Starry Night by the Dutch painter Van Gogh. *Teleférico* was born during a trip to La Paz, Bolivia. *Meditação, Flutuar, Sonhos de Criança, Luar de Irôko, Vôo pra Minas,* and *Café no Bule* complete the repertoire.






The most traditional jazz formation – piano, bass, and drums – is, for Salomão, an environment that allows for many possibilities. "This is when I enjoy improvising the most, and in this project featuring only original compositions, I tried to bring as few pre-established arrangements as possible so that the musicians could play and create freely, bringing their identities into the music," says the pianist. He concludes, "when I develop a project that includes other instrumentalists, I create and write with them in mind, thinking about how they would play, and this inspires me even more."

### About Salomão Soares


Born and raised in Cruz do Espírito Santo, in the countryside of Paraíba, and currently living in São Paulo, Salomão is a pianist, arranger, and composer. He has been standing out as one of the great revelations of the new generation of Brazilian instrumentalists and has shared the stage with prominent names in Brazilian music such as Hermeto Pascoal, Toninho Horta, Hamilton de Holanda, Leny Andrade, Filó Machado, Renato Braz, Mônica Salmaso, Itiberê Zwarg, Arismar do Espírito Santo, Toninho Ferragutti (with whom he recorded a duo album), among many others.


He is the winner of the 2017 MIMO Instrumental Award, a finalist in the Piano Competition at the 2017 Montreux Festival – Switzerland, and the winner of the 2018 New Talents Award at the Savassi Festival in Belo Horizonte (MG). He has participated in various festivals and tours worldwide, including recent performances in Spain and Portugal alongside singer and composer Vanessa Moreno, in Uruguay, and throughout Brazil, such as at SESC Jazz, one of the most renowned jazz festivals in Latin America, with his trio and also as a special guest of Hermeto Pascoal.







